# Project Update - Request for Comments

- New Open Source Policy Draft

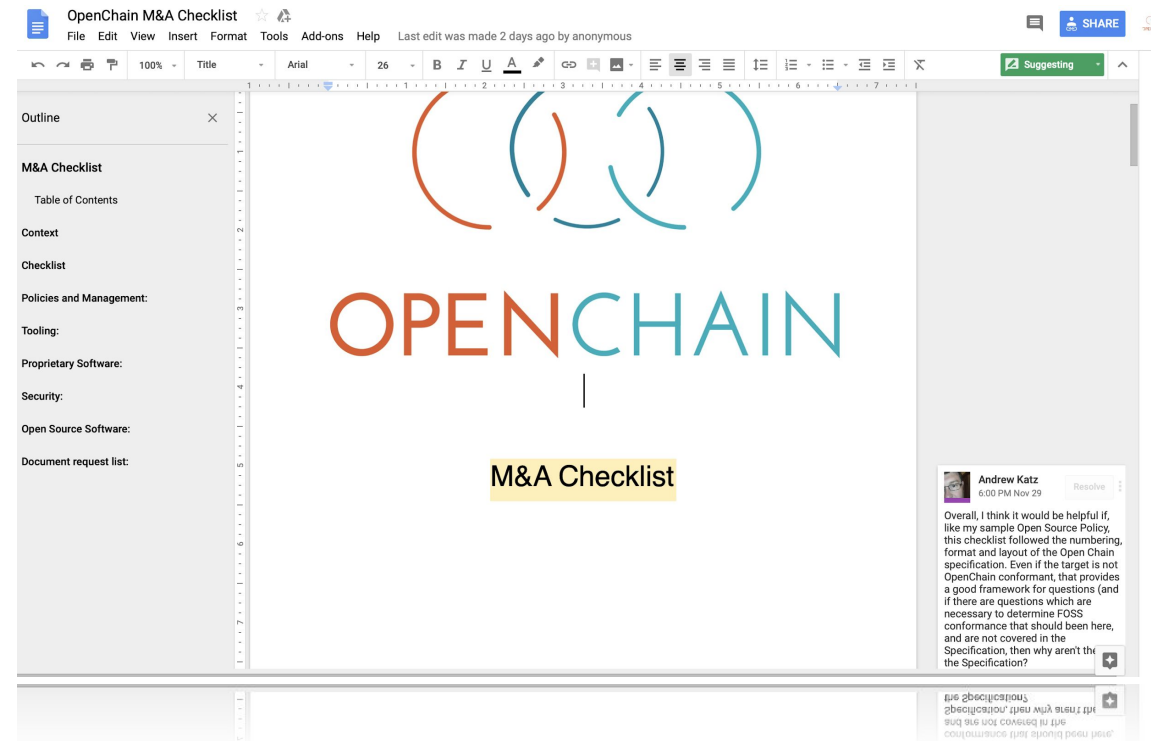
OCS §	Category	Policy Text
		Open Source Liaison - a designated person who is assigned to receive and respond to external open source enquiries.
		Identified License - a set of open source licenses identified as a result of following an appropriate method of identifying licenses that govern the Supplied Software.
		<b>OpenChain Conforming Program</b> - a program that satisfies all the requirements of this specification.
		<b>Software Staff</b> - any employee or contractor that defines, contributes to or has responsibility for preparing Supplied Software. Depending on the organization, that may include (but is not limited to) software developers, release engineers, quality engineers, product marketing and product management.
		<b>SPDX or Software Package Data Exchange</b> - the format standard created by the SPDX Working Group for exchanging license, copyright and security information for a given software package. A description of the SPDX specification can be found at <a href="http://www.spdx.org">www.spdx.org</a> .
		<b>Supplied Software</b> - software that an organization delivers to third parties (e.g., other organizations or individuals).
		<b>Verification Materials</b> - evidence that must exist in order for a given requirement to be considered satisfied.

1.1	A written open source policy exists that governs open source license compliance of the Supplied Software distribution. The policy must be internally communicated.	RQ
1.1.1	A documented open source policy exists.	VA Our open source policy can be found [on the COMPANY] intranet at [LINK]
1.1.2	A documented procedure that makes Software Staff aware of the	VA All joining Software Staff will be made aware of the open source
